Capital letters: ABCDEFGHIJKLMNOPQRSTUVWXYZ


Small letters: abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz


The letters Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo, Uu are called vowels.

**Alphabetical Order:** The order in which we recall all the letters of the English alphabet family, is the alphabetical order.

Example: When we write **a b c d e**, all the letters are in alphabetical order. When we write **a d p c**, the letters are not in alphabetical order.
