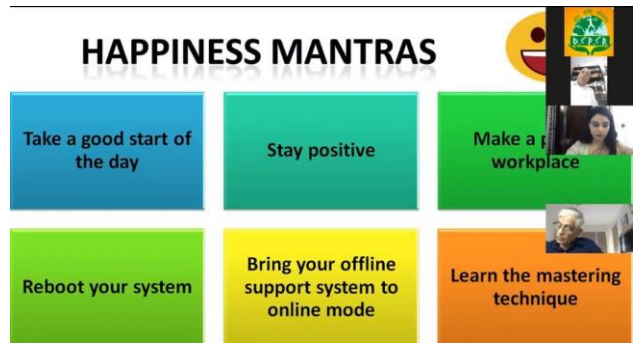
WEBINAR ON CAREER COUNSELLING AND HOW TO REMAIN HAPPY IN UNCERTAINTY

INDEPENDENCE "WEEK" CELEBRATION

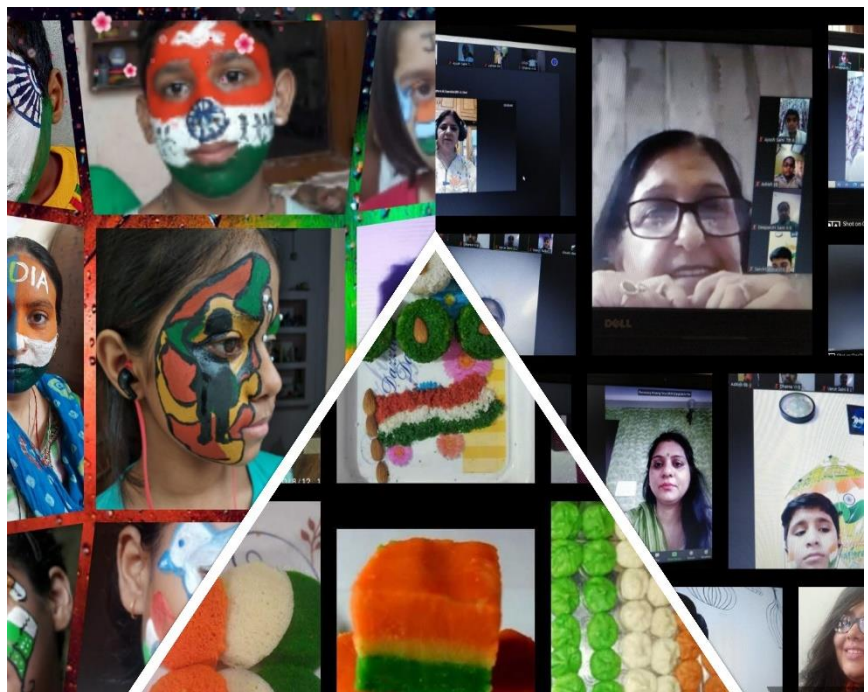

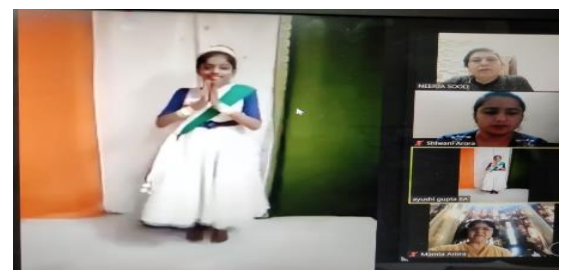
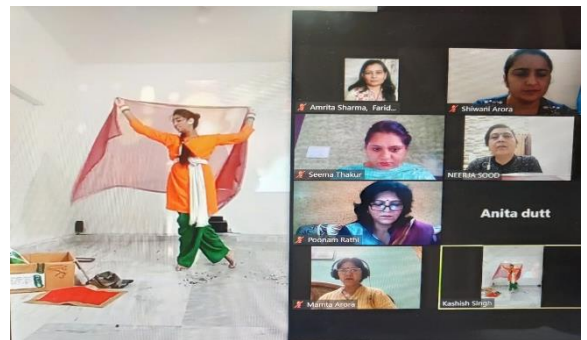
WORLD HUMANITARIAN DAY

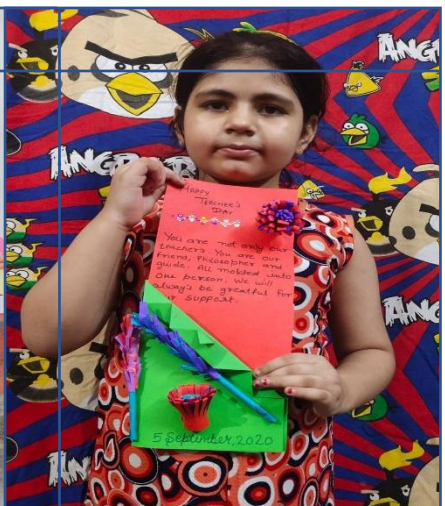
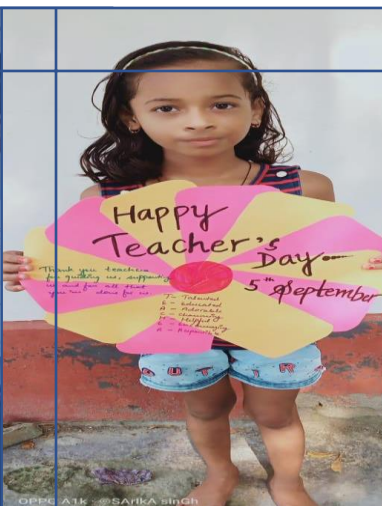
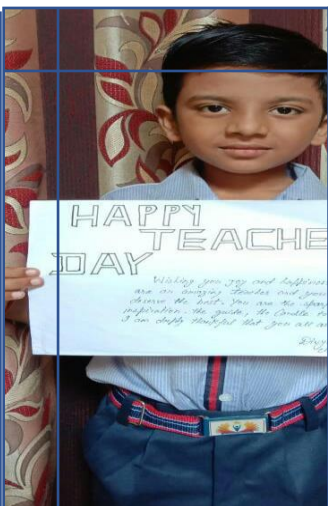
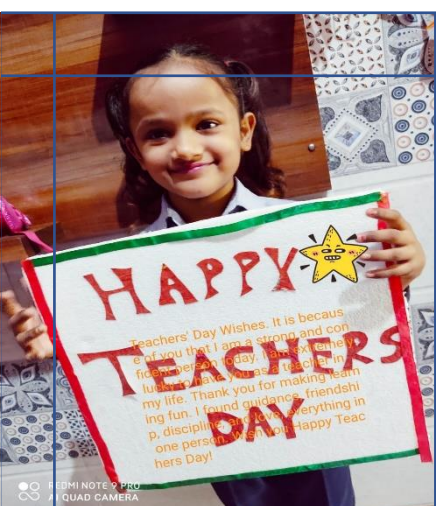
Virtual Teacher's Day Celebration

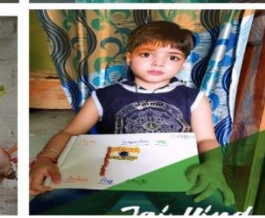
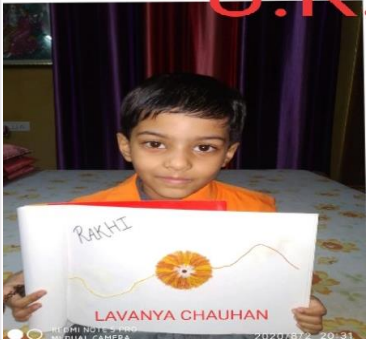
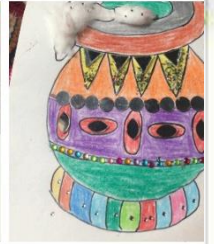

Hindi Recitation Competition

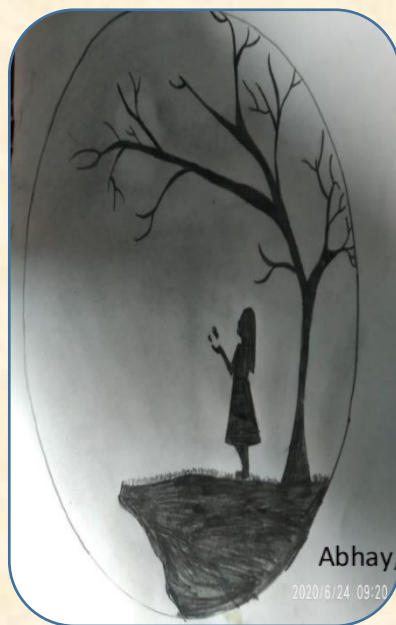
