
COVID-19: Unmasking the new face of Education

ONLINE CLASSES

The covid-19 pandemic has resulted in the closure of schools and colleges across the country since April. Education has changed dramatically over the last two months, with a considerable rise of E-learning, whereby teaching is executed remotely and on digital platforms. Teachers and students enter a new world of virtual lectures, tutorials, and assessments. Though E-learning poses a challenge to both students and teachers over technology and access, it is keeping everyone busy with lectures, worksheets and assignments.

The session commenced on the virtual platform on 1st April 2020. Initially virtual classes started only for IX to XII grades. "A mother is one who can take the place of all others but whose place no one else can take."




INTERNATIONAL ONLINE MATHEMATICS COMPETITION




