## Club Activities Month November 2022

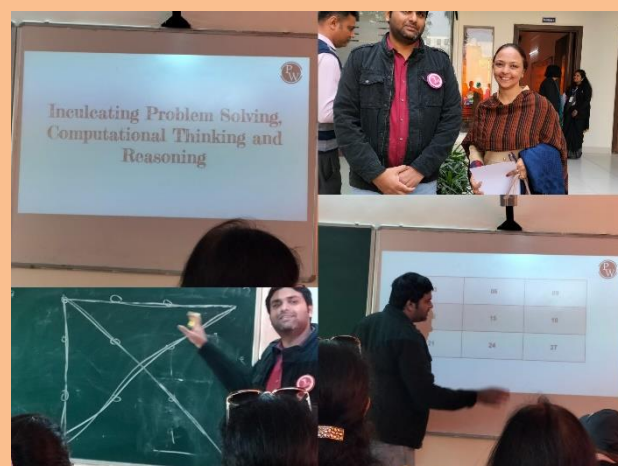
