Waste To Wonder Workshop October 18, 2023

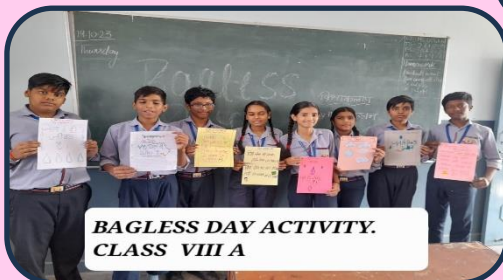

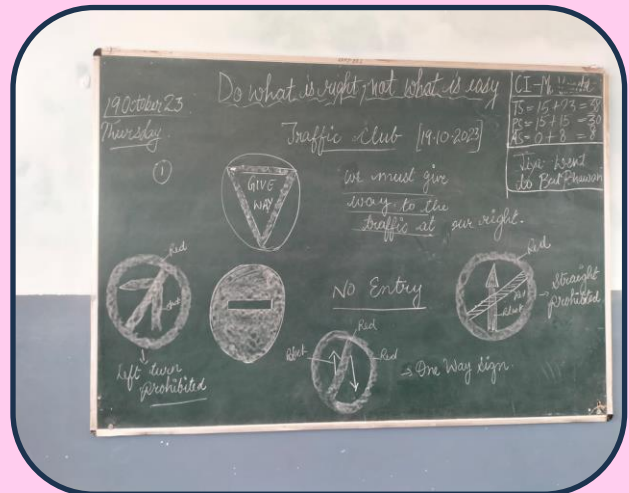
BAGLESS DAY October 19, 2023

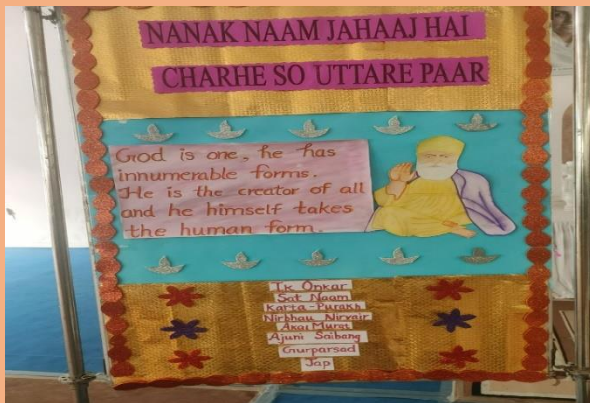

Workshop Personal Hygiene (V- VII girls) December 21, 2023

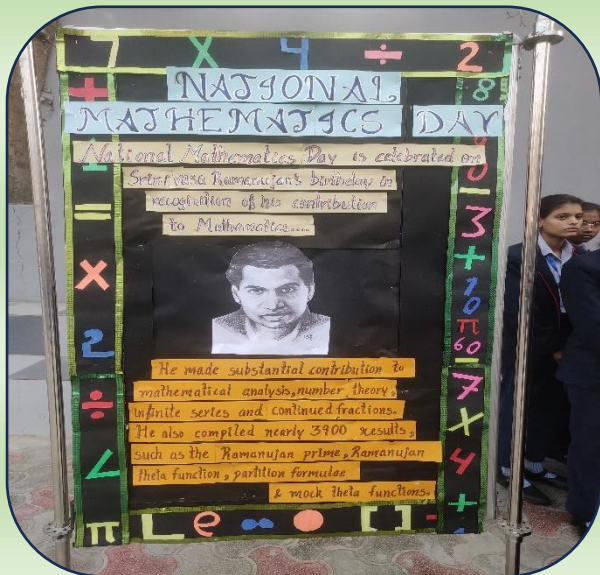

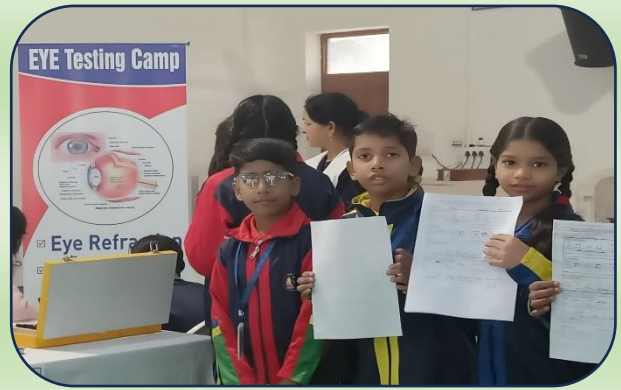


Medical Health Checkup Camp December 27, 2023

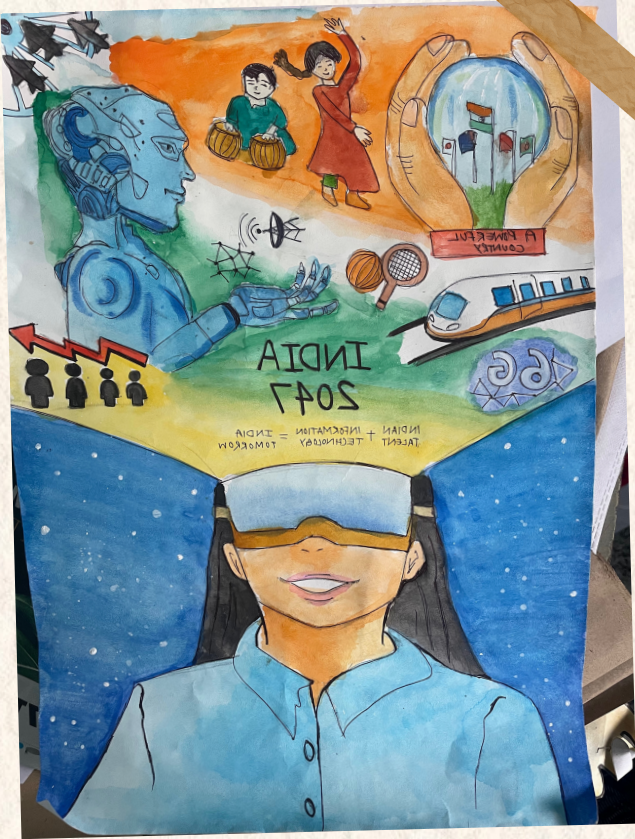
