



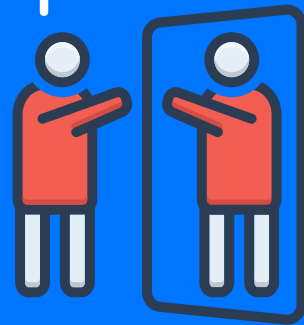

International Plastic Free Day, 11th July 2024

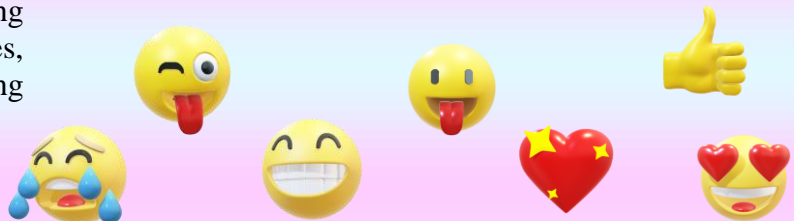

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Tribute to Satguru Mata Savinder ji, 5th August 2024

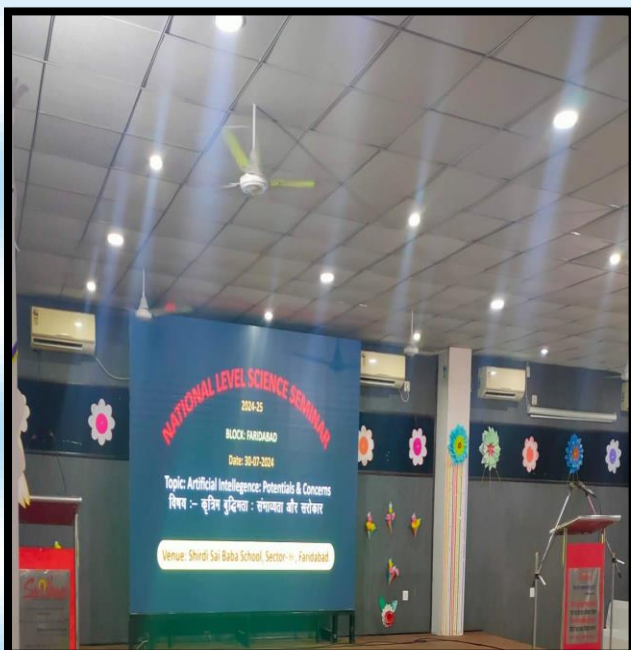

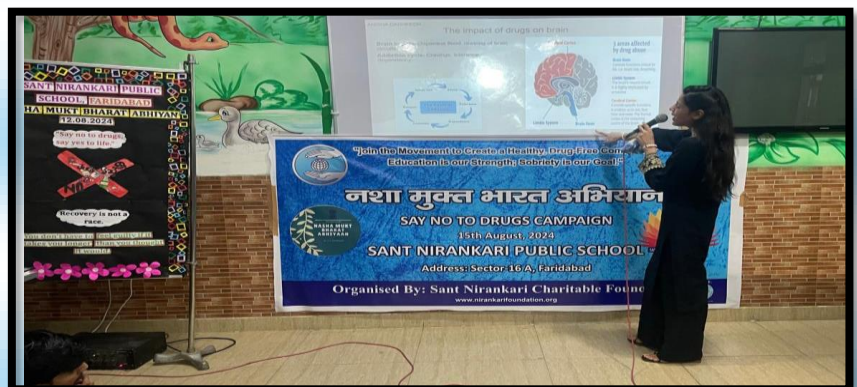
Special Assembly on Quit India Day, 8th August 2024

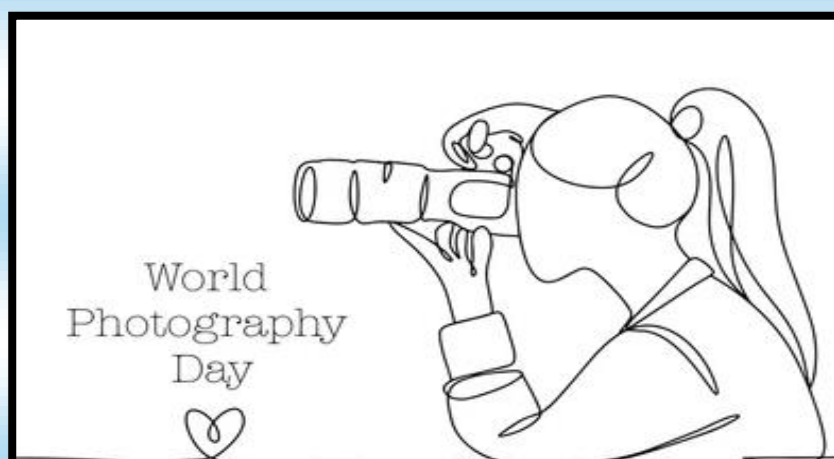
Special Assembly on Raksha Bandhan by the students of class I, 17th August 2024

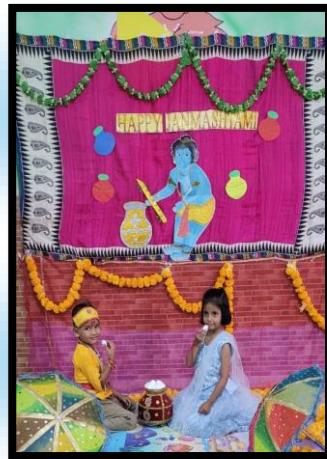




Through these activities, students enriched their knowledge of space exploration & gathered more information about "Bharat on the Moon" campaign.

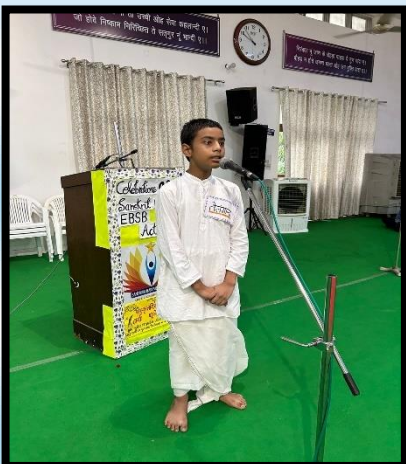
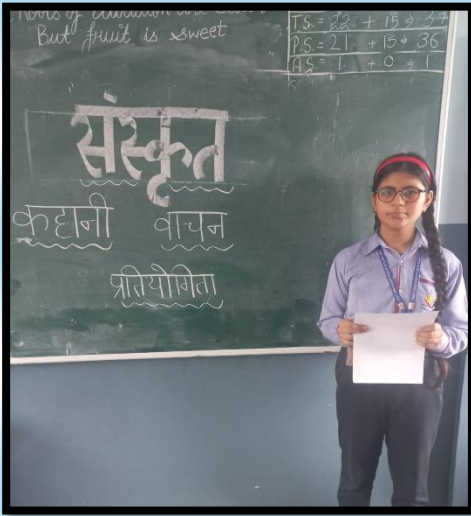


INSPIRE MANAK AWARDS, 27th August 2024

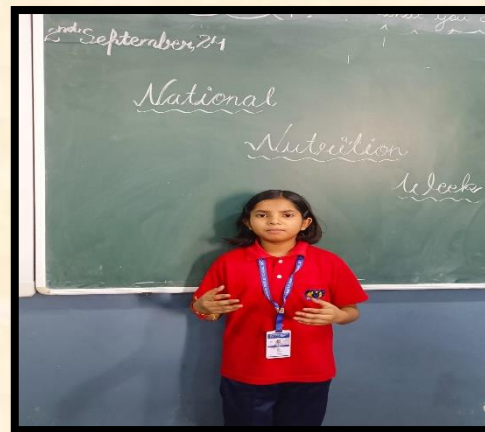

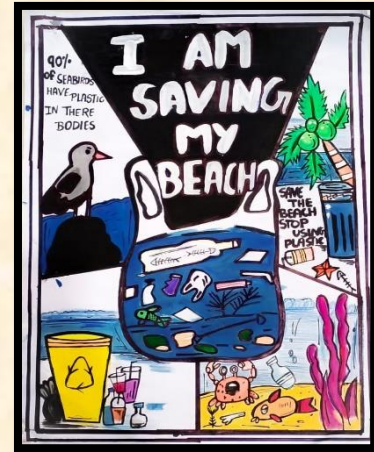
Milad-un-Nabi

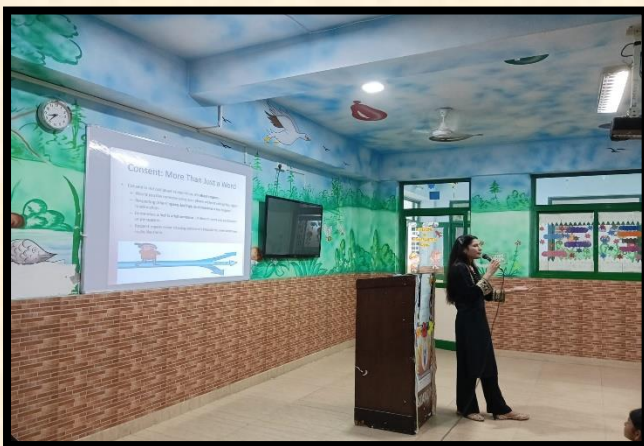
Workshop for classes IV, V, VI "Being an Emotionally intelligent Parent" 21st September 2024
